Description

<p>The First International Event of KASPI 2.0 took place in Hernádkak, Hungary, from 6th to 9th March 2026, marking the official launch of the project's implementation phase and setting the foundation for a renewed European commitment to youth empowerment, digital inclusion, and social dialogue. Building on the successful legacy of the original KASPI initiative, this first gathering represented a strategic continuation of a project model that had already demonstrated its ability to create meaningful cross-border collaboration and long-term civic impact.</p> <p>As a central pillar of KASPI 2.0, the Hernádkak event focused on strengthening digital literacy, equality, and active participation among young people aged 18–22, while promoting inclusive community engagement across European municipalities. The event successfully aligned with the project's wider objectives: enhancing critical digital skills, countering misinformation and hate speech, and reinforcing European solidarity through structured youth dialogue.</p> <p>The event brought together a broad and diverse network of participants, confirming the project's strong international reach and collaborative spirit. A total of 112 local participants from Hernádkak joined the activities, alongside 11 participants each from Castiglione, Miroslav, Lija, Vallerano, and Herrera del Duque, as well as 33 participants from Pomiechówek. This created a vibrant intercultural environment in which experiences, perspectives, and practices could be exchanged openly and constructively.</p> <p>The programme was designed as an immersive five-day experience, combining workshops, seminars, collaborative sessions, and cultural activities. Throughout the event, participants engaged in practical and reflective learning processes aimed at addressing today's digital and social challenges in an inclusive and accessible way. Particular emphasis was placed on ensuring that all voices—regardless of gender, nationality, or social background—were heard, valued, and respected.</p> <p>At the core of the event were two flagship workshops, both of which were successfully implemented as key deliverables of the project:</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. "Bridging Digital Divides: Empowering Youth Through Inclusion, Equality, and Digital Literacy" <p>This workshop served as a cornerstone of the event, addressing the urgent need to strengthen digital competence among young Europeans. Participants explored themes such as online misinformation, cyber-awareness, responsible digital behavior, and equal access to digital tools. Through interactive sessions and follow-up discussions, the workshop emphasized how digital literacy is not merely a technical skill, but a civic necessity in modern democratic societies.</p> <p>The workshop also integrated perspectives on gender equality and inclusion, highlighting the importance of ensuring that digital spaces remain accessible and safe for all. Participants were encouraged to reflect critically on digital inequalities and to propose practical strategies for fostering a more inclusive digital environment in their local communities.</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> 2. "Engaging Voices: Fostering Real-World Dialogue and Social Connections Among Youth" <p>The second workshop focused on rebuilding authentic interpersonal dialogue among young people in an increasingly virtual world. In an era where digital communication often replaces direct human interaction, the workshop addressed the importance of empathy, listening, and community-based engagement.</p> <p>Through collaborative exercises and facilitated group discussions, participants developed practical approaches to strengthening social bonds, promoting active citizenship, and encouraging constructive dialogue across differences. The workshop reinforced the value of face-to-face exchange as a tool for reducing polarization and building resilient, connected communities.</p> <p>Beyond the workshops, the event offered a rich framework of cultural immersion and shared experiences. Participants engaged in local visits, intercultural exchanges, and informal networking opportunities that deepened relationships and strengthened the sense of European belonging. These activities complemented the formal sessions by creating a human-centered environment where</p>			

solidarity and trust could flourish.

The outcomes of the Hernádkak event were both immediate and long-term. On a practical level, the event generated collective reflections, action-oriented recommendations, and collaborative outputs that will contribute directly to the wider objectives of KASPI 2.0. On a strategic level, it reinforced the project's international network and established a shared commitment to sustaining dialogue and cooperation beyond the event itself.

Most importantly, the first event in Hernádkak demonstrated that KASPI 2.0 is not simply a continuation of a previous initiative, but an evolution of a successful model adapted to the pressing realities of 2026. By addressing digital transformation, social inclusion, and youth participation through an innovative and participatory approach, the project reaffirmed its relevance in strengthening democratic resilience and European unity.

The success of this first international event confirms the strong potential of KASPI 2.0 to generate meaningful change across communities. It laid a robust foundation for the project's future activities and proved that empowering young people through education, inclusion, and dialogue remains one of the most effective pathways toward a more connected, informed, and equitable Europe.
